

## Cruise Ship Terminal(s)

**Julia Street Terminal** – Great flow for any type of event. Waiting area is separate from Ticket Queue and Counter, so space is conducive for events needing a large continuous space. Ticket Queue and Counter Area is perfect for staging catering / food and beverage set-up with windows overlooking the water. Screening Queue serves as an excellent pre-function or registration space, while the VIP Room provides a closed-door option for breakout meetings / events. Parking is available at the Riverwalk Surface Parking Lot.

- Permit request / application must be provided at least four (4) months prior to the event for the Board to seek a waiver from the United States Coast Guard (USCG)
- Permit approval is subject to USCG approval of the waiver
- Right of first call – Cruise lines reserve the right to access the premises in connection with their cruise businesses or in the event of an emergency. This may result in a last minute cancellation / adjustment.
