

Strategic Focus on Greening the Supply Chain



Seacor container on barge service: Reduced 9.7 million kg in CO2 emissions and saved 1 million gallons of diesel fuel.



Port NOLA Clean TRIP: Helped replace nearly 100 trucks with cleaner burning engines to improve air quality.



Idle reduction program:

Implemented in 2016 to reduce GHG, air pollutants and noise from vehicles, equipment and locomotives.



EPA-classified Tier 1 locomotives: NOPB has 10 in their fleet; deployed 45 solar power switches across its network.



Louisiana — on the road to net zero greenhouse gas emissions by 2050.



Port NOLA — Green Marine member since 2014 and certified since 2015.
