Louisiana Leaders Celebrate Deepening of the Mississippi River Ship Channel

Louisiana elected officials, federal partners and maritime stakeholders joined the Big River Coalition to celebrate the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers (USACE) completion of the first two phases of the deepening of the Mississippi River Ship Channel, which presently provides a maximum draft for vessels to the Port of New Orleans at 50-feet. The project allows larger vessels carrying more cargo to access maritime facilities on the Lower Mississippi River.
