

## 2018-19 PROCUREMENT SCHEDULE FOR MAJOR PROJECTS

The listing of upcoming procurement activities shown below is only a tentative schedule and vendors are encouraged to check the procurement website for official dates of bid openings. In addition to the major public works project listed below, smaller public works projects valued at under \$50,000 become available periodically and do not require a Louisiana Contractor's License.
